In 2019, after the EPA finalized the designation of 20 chemical substances as high priority for risk evaluation, it has been moving quickly through the process required by TSCA to evaluate any unreasonable risks they may present to human health or the environment. Included in these high-risk chemicals are Methylene chloride, Perchloroethylene, n-Propyl Bromide (1-Bromopropane) and Trichlorethylene. Any actions taken by the EPA will have an impact on metal parts fabricators that use these chemicals for cleaning. This presentation will discuss: Actions to date that the EPA has taken with regard to chlorinated/fluorinated/brominated solvents, Risk mitigation regulations by other regulating bodies, State and producer initiatives. Also, a brief summary of alternatives to solvent cleaning and what to consider if switching: Cost, Footprint, Equipment lead time, and Waste.
